Web site navigation instructions

- 1. Enter the Discovery of Sound in the Sea Web site http://omp.gso.uri.edu/dosits.htm,
- 2. GO TO the Teacher Resources page
- 3. Under Feature Sounds, CLICK ON Snapping Shrimp
- 4. Read the feature sound
- 5. GO TO the Audio Gallery and listen to the snapping shrimp sound clip.
- 6. Open the sound file in teacher activity named mbreach.mp3 (Humpback Whale pectoral slap).
- 7. GO TO the Animals and Sound in the Sea section
- 8. CLICK ON "How do marine animals communicate using sound?"
- 9. Read about how fish use sound to communicate, how marine mammals communicate, and how invertebrates communicate.
- 10. Think about the range of motivations marine animals exhibit for producing non-vocal sounds.
